## Houlihan's martini, dessert might ring a bell

**N**eed a little post-shopping pick-me-up? Houlihan's restaurants at Castleton Square Mall and Noblesville's Hamilton Town Center are offering a couple of festive seasonal specialties through Jan. 20.

The Ding Dong Martini, \$7.95, is a chocolate martini topped by a Hostess Ding Dong, a specialty introduced several years ago and brought back by popular demand.

The Snowball Flight dessert, \$5.95, is a shareable serving of Italian-style doughnuts served with a Kahlua fudge sauce and a Bailey's white chocolate sauce.

"The company wanted to create something that was holiday-oriented but nontraditional, as well as something visual that would turn heads as it was carried through the restaurant to a guest," said Kathleen Stormes, director of marketing for Houlihan's restaurant group.

"Both items have been a huge hit in Indianapolis and around the country. Some restaurants have reported running short on martini glasses due to high demand."
